Hundreds of makers will convene on Columbus, Ohio, for Midwest Craft Con, a three-day retreat for mid-career crafters, makers and creative business owners. This event, the team's third conference, will go to a biennial format after 2018, with the next event in 2020.

- Vickie Howell is a broadcast personality, producer, author, designer, and DIY instructor. She is known as the host of TV shows such as DIY Network's Knitty Gritty and Stylelicious, her best selling knitting, crochet, and craft books. Her latest project is a crowdfunded video series called The Knit Show with Vickie Howell.
